

MEMBERSHIP POLICIES & CLUB RULES

Malibu Bungalows Club designed the Membership Policies ("Policies") and the club rules, including rules listed here and rules posted in clubs ("Rules") to ensure a safer and more enjoyable environment in which to exercise. So, please be thoughtful and observe the Policies and Rules that you, and all members, have agreed to follow. In its sole discretion, modify the Policies and Rules without notice at any time. It's your responsibility to know and follow the most current Policies and Rules. All approved signs posted in a club or on the premises shall be considered a part of the Policies and Rules of The Malibu Bungalows Club.

The following Policies and Rules replace all previous Policies and Rules. If there is any conflict between these Policies and the posted club Rules, these Policies and Rules apply. The current Policies and Rules are also available on the website.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY POLICY STATEMENT

We seek, enroll, and maintains memberships without regard to race, religious creed, color, national origin, ancestry, physical disability, mental disability, medical condition, marital status, sex, sexual orientation, or age. It is further club policy that no circumstance or conduct undertaken by club personnel shall have the effect of discrimination based on any of the classifications. All club members shall have full and equal access to the club facility. All members with disabilities shall be entitled to reasonable accommodations for their physical and mental impairments. Any member who believes that they have been/are being treated unfairly on any of the matters should first report to club management.

RESTROOM ACCESSIBILITY-TRANSGENDER EQUAL OPPORTUNITY POLICY

As set forth in The Malibu Bungalows Club Equal Opportunity Policy, all members shall have full and equal access to the club facility. Consistent with this Policy, all members shall have access to the restroom and locker room facilities that correspond to the member's gender identity, regardless of the member's sex assigned at birth. For example, transgender women (who were born male but identify as female) are permitted to use the women's facilities, and vice versa for transgender men. Each member should determine the most appropriate option for her/him/themself. Any member who has a need or desire for increased privacy, regardless of the reason, will be provided access to a single-person facility, when available. No member, however, shall be required to use such a facility. Any member who believes they have been/are being treated unfairly on any of the Equal Opportunity Policies above should report to the club management.

CLUBHOUSE

Hours may vary from time to time. Coffee and teatime are 8 am to 3:00 pm daily unless otherwise noted. All hours and activities will be posted on our website malibubungalowsclub.com.

Please note due to traffic patterns, changes in the weather and or other unexpected challenges that may or may not arise, the clubhouse may be closed, and members shall be notified on the website as soon as possible of this as well as a message placed on our message system for our phone number.

GUEST PRIVILEGES

The Malibu Bungalows Club encourages you to bring friends, relatives, and business associates for a guest visit. The Malibu Bungalows Club may restrict the number of guests and the times you may bring guests. You must inform guests about these Policies.

USE OF FACILITIES

Availability of Facilities: Malibu Bungalows Club or services, including but not limited to, classes, workshops and or other type of activities may have limited hours, be discontinued altogether at any time, or be offered on a “first come first serve” basis and a registration process. The Malibu Bungalows Club reserves the right to charge a separate participation or reservation fee for any or all these facilities or services. Use of Malibu Bungalows Club facilities or services are authorized and limited pursuant to your membership agreement.

Conflicts Regarding Use: Please remember to share the space with others because other members may need to use it for incremental periods of time. No member should monopolize the sitting areas for long excess periods of time. If there is a sign-up list for the use of the patios or other areas and a maximum time limit on its use, then the directions for the use are part of the club rules and Malibu Bungalows Club expects all the members to follow them. In short, observe neighborly etiquette. If there is a conflict over use, let Malibu Bungalows Club management resolve it.

Specialty Classes Malibu Bungalows Club has specific procedures and rules and may charge for the use of some workshops and or special classes. However, many activities are complimentary for the members enjoyment Please see management or read the posted information for these activities.

No Solicitation: Malibu Bungalows Club facilities are provided for the private use of club members.

GENERAL POLICIES FOR MINORS

Minors Under 12: Must always be accompanied by a parent or guardian when in the facilities, unless the minor is registered in Kids’ Club or participating in an approved youth program. If your minor child does not behave, Malibu Bungalows Club may ask you to make other arrangements.

Minors 12 - 17: May use Malibu Bungalows Club without being accompanied by a parent or guardian if the minor is a member or a guest and their parent or guardian signed the membership agreement Malibu Bungalows Club reserves the right, in its discretion, to require that a parent or guardian accompany a minor.

LOCKERS

Malibu Bungalows Club may provide lockers for some members to use from time to time. You should always use a lock to protect your property. Do not leave any valuable property in a locker at any time. Malibu Bungalows Club is not responsible for any theft of or damage to your property. **If you leave your property for over thirty days without written authorization from management** Malibu Bungalows Club will consider your property abandoned and have the right to cut off the lock. If you leave your property, Malibu Bungalows Club shall have the right to donate your property to charity.

PROHIBITED ITEMS AND ACTIVITIES

No Alcohol, Drugs, or Smoking: You cannot engage in any activity at 24 Hour while under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol. Malibu Bungalows Club does not permit smoking, alcohol, or illegal drugs, including steroids, in any of its facilities.

No Weapons: No weapons of any kind are permitted in Malibu Bungalows Club facilities.

Food & Beverages: Malibu Bungalows Club reserves the right to limit the consumption of food or beverages in certain areas of the property due to the nature and use of the facilities.

CONDUCT

While in Malibu Bungalows Club facilities, Malibu Bungalows Club does not permit and will not tolerate any inappropriate conduct. Such conduct includes, without limitation, using loud, abusive, offensive, insulting, demeaning language, profanity, lewd conduct, or any conduct that harasses or is bothersome to members, guests, or Malibu Bungalows Club staff.

VIOLATION OF POLICIES OR RULES

If any member or guest violates any of the Policies or Rules, Malibu Bungalows Club will ask that person to stop or leave. A member's violation of any of the Policies or Rules may also cause 24 Hour, in its sole discretion, to terminate that person's membership and/or other agreements.

The Malibu Bungalow Club facilities are provided to its creative community member as a place to support and encourage artistic expression, flower beautification and native plant gardening. All members shall agree to provide their support for our mission.
